Award Criteria and Eligibility

Distinguished Past Student Award - for alumnae who have celebrated their 20th reunion

Recognises significant contribution or achievements in the profession, community or volunteer work

- The nominee must have made a notable contribution in her field of endeavour - professional, community or volunteer work.

- for alumnae in their 20th reunion year or younger

Recognises significant contribution or achievements in the profession, community or volunteer work

- The nominee must have made a notable contribution in her field of endeavour - professional, community or volunteer work.
- The nominee must represent the ideals articulated in the St Margaret's Mission Statement - to be a confident, capable, compassionate and contributing member of the community.
- The nominee must be a positive role model to current students.
- The nominee must be living and must have attended St Margaret's.
- The nominee must be those celebrating their 20th reunion or younger.
- Winning this award will not preclude an alumnae from receiving the Distinguished Past Student Award in the future.



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
